

# All That Glitters is Not Gold: Positive Changes and New Challenges for School Library Supervisors

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## About the Lilead Project

The Lilead Project at the University of Maryland's iSchool is supported by the Institute for Museum and Library Services (IMLS). It studies the value, roles, and responsibilities of the individuals who hold the position of library supervisor in their school district. In 2012 and 2014, the Lilead Project surveyed supervisors in the largest districts nationwide. This is the first national study since the 1960s to examine the work of supervisors.

## Research Questions

- What changes have supervisors seen in funding for programs?
- What changes have supervisors seen in staffing at the building level?

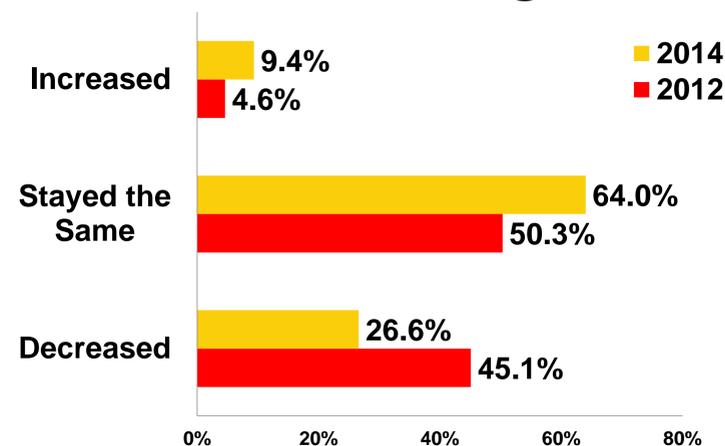
## Study Design

- *Methodology:* Mixed methods online survey; 120 questions in four categories: position and office profiles; roles and responsibilities; challenges, changes, and trends; demographics.
- *Survey Population:* 290 districts in 50 states, including 280 districts with student populations of 25,000 or more, plus the largest districts in each of 10 states without a district with 25,000 students.
- *Responses:*  
2012: 166 supervisors (61% response rate)  
2014: 151 supervisors (57% response rate)

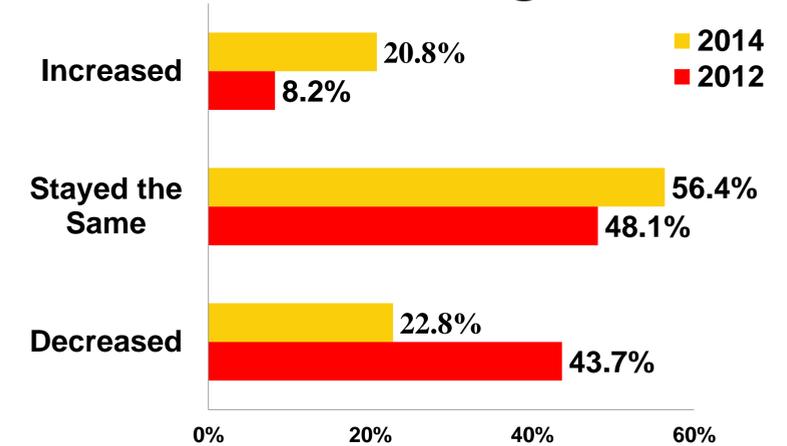
## Findings

During each survey, the supervisors were asked to report how funding, staffing, and the availability of qualified candidates had changed from the previous school year.

### Funding

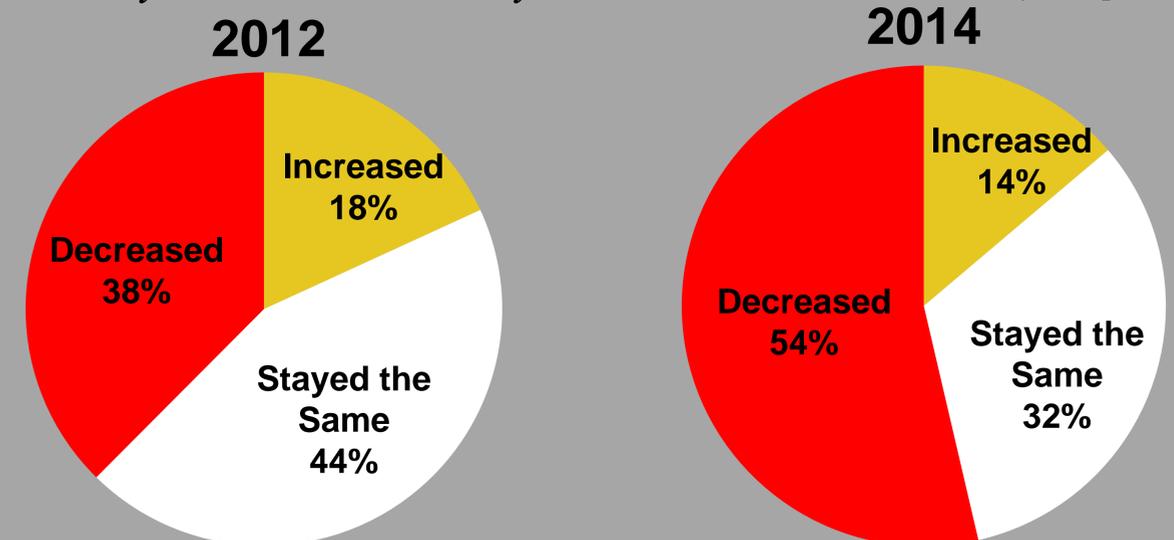


### Staffing
